Re-application for College, Trade or Vocational Scholarship

The purpose of the scholarship includes promoting and encouraging higher education for those individuals whose achievement and character have indicated that they possess the qualities necessary to achieve excellence in higher education. All applicants and recipients must have been **baptized at, confirmed by and be members of Trinity Lutheran Church** of Stillwater, Minnesota.

Renewal scholarships will be awarded on the basis of academic status, co-curricular achievement and good citizenship, the same criteria used the first year you applied for a scholarship. Once selected, a student remaining in fine academic standing as indicated by official record will be eligible to apply for a renewal of this scholarship for up to three additional years. Application for renewal is solely the responsibility of the student. All renewal applications are to be postmarked **no later than April 1** to:

Attach a personal letter addressed to the Trinity Lutheran Scholarship Fund Committee updating us on:

- your progress in school;
- the impact post-secondary education has had on you so far;
- your plans for the upcoming academic year;
- yourself, what you want from a college/trade/vocational education;
- any additional information you want the Scholarship Committee to consider.

For federal income tax purposes these awards are nontaxable as long as (1) the recipient is a degree candidate, (2) a condition of the award is that the money must be used for "qualified tuition and related expenses" (tuition and enrollment fees, books, supplies, and equipment required for courses, but not room and board or incidental expenses), and (3) the recipient establishes that the money was actually used for the intended purposes. To the extent of the scholarship awarded, trust funds will be paid to the institution which the recipient is attending, or to the recipient if the recipient provides the Committee with a paid receipt from the institution which the recipient is attending.
